Events in 2015 added \$35,000, €134,000 to fuel researchers' efforts to save lives

The journey continues. Beginning our 10th year, A Sister's Hope is as committed as ever to forge forward and do whatever we can to give researchers the financing they need, to give hope to the patients (and those who love them) who are facing breast cancer.

In 2016, A Sister's Hope will hold its final 60K Walk from Bussum to Amsterdam, The Netherlands. Many walks, runs, bike rides and other events have surfaced over the past nine years and, though this abundance of selfproclaimed charity events are attracting participation and euro from people across the country, breast cancer researchers are finding it MORE difficult to obtain funding than in the past. A Sister's Hope is overwhelmed with requests for funding of promising breast cancer research projects. So instead of being lost in that crowd of events, we will do different things in the future. The 60K Walk ignited many charitable actions in The Netherlands and now we will take the lead again.


