A SISTER'S HSPE



A Sister's Hope in 2010 surpassed 2.7 million euro raised for breast cancer research in The Netherlands. The percentage of individual donations going to the researchers in four years has ranged from 82.3% to 88.9%, averaging more than 85%. Part of the reason this impressive percentage has been possible is due to the generosity of sponsors Breast Friends/ Roche, DHL Express, and all the in-kind donations of items used for the events. When more walkers and crew participate, more money is raised and the percentage of donations going to research is higher. Let's work together to move that percentage toward 100%!
